 It's not unusual for Christians to think of the early church as the "" church. However, a careful reading of the New Testament reveals that the early church was by many of the same issues confronting our churches today.
3. The Galatians, for instance, were exchanging the grace of God for their own works
a temptation many struggle with today.
4. How would you complete this statement?
"When I die, I will spend eternity with God because"
5. If we believe that our depends on Jesus + anything else, then we have failed to un-
derstand the nature of the grace God has poured out upon us.
6. The Corinthian church was a mess, with, sexual immorality, disputes about spiritual
gifts, and problems in their worship services, rampant among the congregation.
7. Paul's response to these issues is to remind the Corinthians that he didn't come to them with eloquent
words, or the of the world, as he told them about Jesus.
8. Instead, he wanted their faith to rest on the unshakeable and unassailable of God.
9. Therefore, he resolved to know nothing while he was with them except the
Christ. The crucifixion and resurrection were at the core of his preaching and teaching.
10. But the message of the cross is to those who are perishing.
11. The world, in its wisdom, wants to separate the of Christianity from the person and
power of God.
