## Sermon Notes

### **Christ Crucified - 1 Corinthians 2:1-5 - Communion Service**

1. It's not unusual for Christians to think of the early church as the "\_\_\_\_\_ " church.
2. However, a careful reading of the New Testament reveals that the early church was \_\_\_\_\_ by many of the same issues confronting our churches today.
3. The Galatians, for instance, were exchanging the grace of God for their own works \_\_\_\_\_ – a temptation many struggle with today.
4. How would you complete this statement?  
    “When I die, I will spend eternity with God because ...”
5. If we believe that our \_\_\_\_\_ depends on Jesus + anything else, then we have failed to understand the nature of the grace God has poured out upon us.
6. The Corinthian church was a mess, with \_\_\_\_\_, sexual immorality, disputes about spiritual gifts, and problems in their worship services, rampant among the congregation.
7. Paul's response to these issues is to remind the Corinthians that he didn't come to them with eloquent words, or the \_\_\_\_\_ of the world, as he told them about Jesus.
8. Instead, he wanted their faith to rest on the unshakeable and unassailable \_\_\_\_\_ of God.
9. Therefore, he resolved to know nothing while he was with them except the \_\_\_\_\_ Christ. The crucifixion and resurrection were at the core of his preaching and teaching.
10. But the message of the cross is \_\_\_\_\_ to those who are perishing.
11. The world, in its wisdom, wants to separate the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christianity from the person and power of God.
12. Even a miracle isn't enough to make most people believe because the \_\_\_\_\_ mind cannot accept \_\_\_\_\_ truth.
13. The crucifixion and resurrection are \_\_\_\_\_ blocks to the world but to those who are being saved they are at the very \_\_\_\_\_ of our faith.
14. The “natural” mind would seek to \_\_\_\_\_ sin through good deeds – to try harder and to work for our righteousness.
15. But God would not be \_\_\_\_\_ if He simply overlooked the reality of our sin because we've also done some good.
16. Simply doing away with sin doesn't work either because sin is not just determined by the transgression but by the One who has been sinned against, and all sin is ultimately sin against \_\_\_\_\_ .
17. We are unable to \_\_\_\_\_ for our transgressions before a Holy God. But the good news is that God \_\_\_\_\_ His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8)
18. God did for us, what we could not do for ourselves. “He has \_\_\_\_\_ you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from \_\_\_\_\_ ...” (Colossians 1:19-22, NIV84)
19. Therefore, there is now no \_\_\_\_\_ for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. (Romans 8:1-2, NIV84)
