## Sermon Notes

Body Life - 1 Thessalonians 5:12-15 - Series: 1 Thessalonians - #23

1. While some believe they don't need "organized religion," a structured, organized \_\_\_\_\_, is God's idea.
2. Paul instructs the Thessalonians to \_\_\_\_\_ those who work hard among them, who are over them in the Lord, and who admonish them.
3. Leadership in the church is not a matter of one's value or worth, but rather one of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.
4. The gifts we have received, and the role we play in the body of Christ, are determined by the \_\_\_\_\_. These gifts have been given for the \_\_\_\_\_ good.
5. The goal that these gifts are driving towards is the attainment, of each part of the body, to the whole measure of the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ.
6. When we choose not to participate in body life, or to serve one another, we are \_\_\_\_\_, not just ourselves, but others, of the gifts that God has given to us, and the church, is the \_\_\_\_\_ for it.
7. Those appointed for leadership in our churches have been given a sacred charge – to watch over the local church, the local body of Christ, as a \_\_\_\_\_ does the \_\_\_\_\_ under his care.
8. Among other qualifications, elders are to be \_\_\_\_\_ – not meaning perfect – but that they seek to walk closely with God and to keep in step with the Holy Spirit.
9. All the qualifications expected of an elder, with the exception of the ability to \_\_\_\_\_, should be characteristic of every Christian.
10. As a function of leadership, the elder is to be a spiritual superintendent of sorts, exercising spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ and spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ within a congregation.
11. Those elders who work hard providing spiritual care and oversight, who seek to feed and protect the flock, who speak God's truth in love, are to be respected and loved – not as those who \_\_\_\_\_ it over others but as those who \_\_\_\_\_ amongst them.
12. Christians are joined together in unity in one Lord, one Faith, one Baptism, one Spirit, and one God, but \_\_\_\_\_ is not the same as \_\_\_\_\_. God has granted unique gifts, experiences, and passions to each one.
13. The unity and peace in a church are threatened by gossip. "Gossip is the opposite of the \_\_\_\_\_." (Matt Mitchell)
14. Gossip, by nature, is \_\_\_\_\_, furtive, and sly. It happens behind a person's back.
15. To help keep the \_\_\_\_\_ in the family of God, each of us needs to be careful that we do not gossip about others, nor encourage the gossiping of others, by \_\_\_\_\_ to it.
16. The unity and peace in a church are threatened by the assumptions we make regarding the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of others.
17. The unity and peace in a church are threatened by our tendency to talk \_\_\_\_\_ those who have hurt us, or wronged us in some way, rather than talking \_\_\_\_\_ them.
18. When we live life in the body in accordance with the pattern God has given us, then the church grows \_\_\_\_\_, the fellowship we share \_\_\_\_\_, the joy we have in one another's presence \_\_\_\_\_, and our witness to the world, \_\_\_\_\_.
