## Sermon Notes

All In The Family - 1 Thessalonians 5:14-15 - Series: 1 Thessalonians - #25

1. While it's true that God is doing a work in each believer, conforming us to the character of Christ, it's just as true that each of us is a "\_\_\_\_\_."
2. The "\_\_\_\_\_" we bring into God's family can lead to tensions and conflicts between believers.
3. It's not that \_\_\_\_\_ exist within a church that is the real issue – it's how we handle them that matters.
4. In these verses we find \_\_\_\_\_ on how to deal with five different types of people that exist within our churches.
5. We are to warn those within the church who are \_\_\_\_\_. We warn them, not out of a judgmental spirit, but a genuine \_\_\_\_\_ and desire to see them walking closely with the Lord.
6. Paul makes it clear that faith is \_\_\_\_\_ – none of us are meant to be bystanders – God intends for us to be engaged in the life of the family He is building.
7. Those who primarily view the church as a building, are more likely to be \_\_\_\_\_. They will rarely be willing to step up and do their part to help a body of believers to grow stronger and healthier.
8. Those who primarily view the church as a gathering of the redeemed, are more likely to be \_\_\_\_\_. They will find ways to step up to build into the church family because they understand that they have a responsibility to their fellow believers.
9. Within every family of believers there will be those who are timid – literally, the "\_\_\_\_\_."
10. The spiritually timid tend to lean heavily on \_\_\_\_\_ and are uneasy at the thought of trying new things.
11. We are to come alongside the fainthearted and \_\_\_\_\_ them, helping them to see the power and presence of God in the moments of each day.
12. To encourage someone is to help them see what is \_\_\_\_\_ and to remind them of who they are in Christ.
13. Within every family of believers there will be those who are \_\_\_\_\_.
14. We are to come alongside the \_\_\_\_\_ weak (the elderly, the injured, the sick) to help them in practical ways.
15. Those who are \_\_\_\_\_ weak tend to struggle with temptation and find themselves falling into the same sins repeatedly.
16. Those who are spiritually weak may become legalistic, \_\_\_\_\_ the freedom we have in Christ.
17. We are to come alongside the spiritually weak and help them to grow in their knowledge and experience of \_\_\_\_\_ as we walk with them.
18. Within every family of believers there will be those who try our \_\_\_\_\_.
19. To be patient is to be long-suffering. It is to be slow to anger. It is to show the same \_\_\_\_\_ to others that God has shown to us.
20. Within every family of believers there will be those who seek to pay back \_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_.
21. But this is not God's will for us. We are not to be \_\_\_\_\_ by evil, but to \_\_\_\_\_ evil with good.
22. We are to actively \_\_\_\_\_ that which is good and right and pleasing to God in each of our relationships, seeking to live at \_\_\_\_\_ with one another, and forgiving others as we, ourselves, have been forgiven by God.
