## Sermon Notes

### **Sanctify! - 1 Thessalonians 5:23-28 - Series: 1 Thessalonians - #28**

1. In just 89 verses, Paul speaks of Jesus some \_\_\_\_\_ times in this letter.
2. The Thessalonians received Paul's message as it was – the very \_\_\_\_\_ spoken to them.
3. They stood as \_\_\_\_\_ to God's grace and were emboldened to \_\_\_\_\_ the message of the Gospel in the face of much opposition.
4. A life pleasing to God is one that is comforted, encouraged, and strengthened, by the promise of Christ's \_\_\_\_\_.
5. Instead of paying back wrong for wrong, we are to seek to live at \_\_\_\_\_, being kind to one another, and overcoming evil with blessing and \_\_\_\_\_.
6. We are to \_\_\_\_\_ everything, holding on to that which is good, and true, and pleasing to God, and avoiding every kind of evil.
7. Paul establishes a clear \_\_\_\_\_ between a life lived according to the ways of this world system and one that has been, and is being, transformed by God's grace.
8. \_\_\_\_\_ serves as the "bookends" of Paul's writings. Whether encouragement, instruction, or rebuke, the backdrop is God's redeeming grace.
9. Grace – God's unmerited favor - is at the very heart of our Christian \_\_\_\_\_.
10. Paul prays that God's unmerited favor, and all that that entails, be with the Thessalonians in the midst of the \_\_\_\_\_, joys, and struggles, they face.
11. Paul charges the Thessalonians to give themselves to the reading of the \_\_\_\_\_.
12. If we say we desire God's will to be done on earth, as it is in heaven, then we must move in a willing \_\_\_\_\_ to His revealed word.
13. The "holy kiss" Paul instructed the Thessalonians to greet each other with was a sign of the \_\_\_\_\_ they shared and the bonds of faith that joined them together as new creations.
14. The equivalent in our day would be a \_\_\_\_\_ or a \_\_\_\_\_. The physical manner of the greeting is not as important as it is that we do greet one another with warmth and genuineness.
15. Paul coveted the prayers of Christians because he knew that the battle was not against flesh and blood, but against the \_\_\_\_\_ powers and principalities of this dark world.
16. What are some of the ways in which we can be praying for one another throughout the course of each week?
17. Paul prays that the Thessalonians would be \_\_\_\_\_ and kept blameless at the coming of the Lord. To be "sanctified" means to be "made holy," and "set apart," for God.
18. Jesus prayed that His followers would be made holy (sanctified) as we received, and walked in obedience to, God's revealed \_\_\_\_\_.
19. God is \_\_\_\_\_ a people who have been, and are being, sanctified, that they may shine the light of Christ into the darkness of this world.
20. \_\_\_\_\_ sanctification is the process by which we are growing to become increasingly like Jesus. With the help of the Holy Spirit we embrace the life that God has made possible in Christ.
21. A Christian who is growing in sanctification becomes increasingly \_\_\_\_\_ to the Master and the work of the kingdom of God. (2 Timothy 2:20-21)
