## Sermon Notes

### **Body and Blood - 1 Corinthians 11:17-30**

1. Like those we read about in the pages of the Bible, we \_\_\_\_\_ that we, too, have sinned and fallen short of God's glory.
2. Yet, as we read the Scriptures, we find God meeting with a people \_\_\_\_\_ by sin, and we catch glimpses of His grace and mercy, as well as His great love for, the people of His creation.
3. The church in Corinth was no exception to this – God had brought them out of the darkness of a society enslaved to every kind of \_\_\_\_\_, and into the light of His goodness and grace.
4. The Corinthians may have been new creations in Christ, but they struggled to live in a manner in keeping with the reality of their \_\_\_\_\_.
5. Paul rebukes them, for there are \_\_\_\_\_ within the local church, that have shattered the unity and fellowship they should have been experiencing.
6. By their actions, they are “ \_\_\_\_\_ the church of God” and “ \_\_\_\_\_ ” their fellow believers.
7. The Corinthians needed to look past the differences that existed between them, and to \_\_\_\_\_ that which they had in common: one Lord, one faith, one baptism and one God.
8. These divisions were made evident in their celebration of the \_\_\_\_\_. The rich went away well satisfied while the poor went away hungry.
9. They had lost sight of the truth that they were each sinners in need of God's \_\_\_\_\_. Some (falsely) saw themselves as more worthy than others.
10. Believers of every era are called to put off the things of the \_\_\_\_\_ nature and to put on their new \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ.
11. God's purpose in the sacrifice of Christ was to \_\_\_\_\_ for the sin that separates us from Him and to empower us to live lives which testify to His glory.
12. By losing sight of the unity they were meant to have in Christ, by living with divisions and factions and all the rest – the Corinthians were sinning against the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ.
13. As we come together for worship, we proclaim God's \_\_\_\_\_: the Messiah has come, sin has been atoned for, forgiveness extended, and reconciliation made possible.
14. Our lives bear testimony to this \_\_\_\_\_ for we have been made new creations in Christ.
15. We have been entrusted with this message of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_, and are charged with sharing it with others, that they may enter into the same hope, and new life, that we have received.
16. The Corinthians were to \_\_\_\_\_ themselves, to search their hearts for sin, that they might repent and be \_\_\_\_\_, that relationships might be healed, and God glorified in their worship. May we be faithful to do the same!
