## Sermon Notes

Those Who Have Not Heard - Acts 10:23a-43 - Series: Last Things - #3

1. Cornelius was a righteous and \_\_\_\_\_ man, who gave generously to those in need.
2. His story illustrates that \_\_\_\_\_ of belief doesn't necessarily equate to salvation. People genuinely believe all manner of things but still die unreconciled to God.
3. This passage also reveals that \_\_\_\_\_ - as defined by the world - is insufficient for salvation.
4. Just as it is not enough for a person to be spiritual, being \_\_\_\_\_ isn't the answer either.
5. Despite being sincere, spiritual, and religious, Cornelius' \_\_\_\_\_ was still so great that God spoke to this man in a vision.
6. Furthermore, Cornelius' need to hear the gospel was so great, that God brought about a \_\_\_\_\_ in Peter's heart.
7. Cornelius' encounter with Peter helps us to understand that the \_\_\_\_\_ of our faith, matters.
8. God-fearing man that he was, Cornelius still needed to hear the \_\_\_\_\_ about Jesus, before he could be saved.
9. Whoever believes in Jesus is not \_\_\_\_\_, but whoever does not believe stands \_\_\_\_\_ already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. (John 3:18)
10. We have trouble \_\_\_\_\_ our image of a loving, gracious, and merciful God, with one who would consign someone to an eternity of torment.
11. And so, we have a tendency to make God in our image - imposing upon Him our own sense of morality and \_\_\_\_\_.
12. But we must be cautious in doing so, for there is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to \_\_\_\_\_. (Proverbs 16:25)
13. The ways and thoughts of God are higher than our ways and thoughts. (Isaiah 55:8-9) That which we can know about God, we know because He has \_\_\_\_\_ to reveal Himself to us.
14. The "good people don't go to hell" argument falls short because there are no " \_\_\_\_\_ " people before God. We all like sheep have gone astray. (Isaiah 53:6)
15. Another reason the "good people go to hell" argument falls short is because salvation is by \_\_\_\_\_ and not by \_\_\_\_\_.
16. If we could be \_\_\_\_\_ by our works, then Jesus' death wasn't necessary to atone for our sin.
17. God is a just God, and when He stands in judgement over the nations, each and every person, will be without \_\_\_\_\_.
18. Humanity is without excuse because the \_\_\_\_\_ of God's existence is visible all around us. All creation testifies to the glory of our God.
19. We condemn ourselves before God, not based on what has not been \_\_\_\_\_ to us, but because we \_\_\_\_\_, or deny, that which has been revealed.
20. Whether under the law, like the Jews were, or apart from the law, as the Gentiles were, each one was without excuse before God, and is \_\_\_\_\_ condemned by their own unbelief, rejection, and rebellion, against their Creator.
21. The good news, is that those who \_\_\_\_\_ to the revelation they have received, by \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord, will find Him if they look for Him with all of their heart, and with all of their soul. (Deuteronomy 4:29)
22. For the Son of Man came to seek and to \_\_\_\_\_ what was lost." (Luke 19:10)
