Daniel's Seventy Sevens - Daniel 9:20-27 - Series: Last Things - #10

1. According to the Scriptures, the next event on the prophetic timetable is the _____ of the true church.
2. The purpose of the Rapture is to remove the church from the earth ahead of the time of _____ that is to come.
3. At some point following the Rapture, but before the Second Coming, believers will stand before the _____ of Christ and give an account of their lives.
4. Those who have been _____ to God's calling upon their lives will be rewarded at this time.
5. Under the reign of King Josiah, the nation of Judah experienced a great spiritual _____.
6. However, after Josiah's death, the nation once again descended into a downward spiral of _____ against the LORD. As a result, God raises up the Babylonians to overthrow the Jews.
7. With the destruction of Jerusalem, the best and the brightest of the survivors are taken captive. _____ was one of those taken to Babylon to serve the Babylonian king.
8. This was the beginning of the _____ years of captivity that was prophesied in Jeremiah 25:11.
9. As the end of that 70-year period draws near, Daniel humbles himself and prays, _____ the sins of the nation and pleading with God to be faithful to His promise of deliverance.
10. In response to this prayer, God sends a message to Daniel via the angel Gabriel. Gabriel speaks of the "seventy sevens" (_____ weeks of _____ years each) that are to come for the nation of Israel.
11. The period of time denoted by the seven-sevens (49 years) began with the decree to rebuild _____ in 445 B.C. It comes to a close in 396 B.C. when the last stone is laid, and the city's restoration is complete.
12. This is followed by a period of sixty-two sevens (434 years) after which the Anointed One (the _____) would be cut off (killed).
13. Gabriel tells Daniel that after the Messiah has been killed, that the city and the temple, would be destroyed. This happens in _____ when the Roman siege overcomes the defenders, and the city is levelled.
