Sermon Notes

Daniel's Seventy Sevens - Daniel 9:20-27 - Series: Last Things - #10

 According to the Scriptures, the next event on the prophetic timetable is the of the true church.
2. The purpose of the Rapture is to remove the church from the earth ahead of the time ofthat is to come.
3. At some point following the Rapture, but before the Second Coming, believers will stand before the of Christ and give an account of their lives.
4. Those who have been to God's calling upon their lives will be rewarded at this time.
5. Under the reign of King Josiah, the nation of Judah experienced a great spiritual
6. However, after Josiah's death, the nation once again descended into a downward spiral of against the LORD. As a result, God raises up the Babylonians to overthrow the Jews.
7. With the destruction of Jerusalem, the best and the brightest of the survivors are taken captive was one of those taken to Babylon to serve the Babylonian king.
8. This was the beginning of the years of captivity that was prophesied in Jeremiah 25:11.
9. As the end of that 70-year period draws near, Daniel humbles himself and prays, the sins of the nation and pleading with God to be faithful to His promise of deliverance.
10. In response to this prayer, God sends a message to Daniel via the angel Gabriel. Gabriel speaks of the "seventy sevens" (weeks of years each) that are to come for the nation of srael.
11. The period of time denoted by the seven-sevens (49 years) began with the decree to rebuild in 445 B.C. It comes to a close in 396 B.C. when the last stone is laid, and the city's restoration is complete.
12. This is followed by a period of sixty-two sevens (434 years) after which the Anointed One (the) would be cut off (killed).
13. Gabriel tells Daniel that after the Messiah has been killed, that the city and the temple, would be destroyed. This happens in when the Roman siege overcomes the defenders, and the city is levelled.
14. With Israel's rejection of the Messiah, God hits the "pause button." With 483 years of the prophecy fulfilled, we are living in the between the ending of that period, and the beginning of the final 7 years of the prophecy spoken to Daniel.
15. Because the Jews rejected Jesus, "salvation has come to the Gentiles to make Israel " (Romans 11:11)
16. Israel has experienced a partial "" until the full number of Gentiles has "come in." (Romans 11:25)
17. In order to understand the events of the end-times, it is crucial to understand that "," and the "," are not one and the same. They stand distinct in God's plans and purposes.
18. The focus of this final seven years will be on the nation of as the church will have been raptured shortly before the seven years of tribulation begins.
19. As we contemplate prophecies such as those found in Daniel, we can be comforted and encouraged, and even in our faith, as we recognize God's unfailing faithfulness to His promises.
