## Sermon Notes

### The 144,000 Witnesses - Revelation 7:1-8 - Series: Last Things - #14

1. The “\_\_\_\_\_” that Jesus warns His disciples about in Matthew 24 are likely brought about by the seal judgements found in Revelation 6.
2. The First Seal -  
The \_\_\_\_\_ comes on the scene, and rises to power, in the aftermath of the rapture.
3. The Second Seal -  
\_\_\_\_\_ is taken from the earth. Incidents of violence and war increase dramatically.
4. The Third Seal -  
\_\_\_\_\_ brings hardship and suffering upon the nations of the earth.
5. The Fourth Seal -  
Death and Hades. \_\_\_\_\_ of the earth’s population will be killed by violence, famine, plague, or wild beasts.
6. The Fifth Seal -  
The souls of the \_\_\_\_\_ call cry out to God to be avenged.
7. The Sixth Seal -  
A devastating \_\_\_\_\_ rocks the foundations of the world, the sun turns black, the moon turns red, and stars fall from the sky.
8. With the sixth seal opened, the nations will finally understand that this is God’s \_\_\_\_\_ on a world moving in rebellion against Him. Yet, because of the hardness of their hearts, many will still refuse to \_\_\_\_\_.
9. In the face of such devastation and destruction people will ask, “Who can stand? Who can survive? Is there anyplace that hope can be found?”
10. In the midst of His \_\_\_\_\_ God will remember His \_\_\_\_\_. He will choose and seal 144,000 individuals who can stand among the nations, untouched by the devastation that has been poured out, and who offer hope to a world on the brink of ruin.
11. The 144,000 will be made up of 12,000 \_\_\_\_\_ from each of the twelve tribes listed in Revelation 7.
12. As God has protected others (Noah and his family, Lot and his family, Rahab, etc.) so too will God protect these 144,000 from the judgements He brings upon the earth, as well as from the \_\_\_\_\_ intent of the antichrist.
13. The tribulation period will not only be a time of unprecedented judgement, but also of \_\_\_\_\_.
14. The 144,000 Jews from the twelve tribes of Israel, mentioned in Revelation 7, will have come to faith in the aftermath of the \_\_\_\_\_.
15. These 144,000 will be witnesses for God, boldly \_\_\_\_\_ His word, and calling people to repentance and faith in Jesus. Multitudes will come to believe through their ministry.
16. God raised up the Jews to be His \_\_\_\_\_ to the world. But because of their sin, rebellion, unbelief, and rejection of the Messiah, Israel failed to shine as a beacon of hope.
17. Because of the hardness of their hearts, the nation of Israel was made \_\_\_\_\_ to the truth of who Jesus is and of what He has done for us. While there are Messianic Jews today, the nation as a whole continues to \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus.
18. The 144,000 Jewish witnesses of Revelation 7 will accomplish what the nation of Israel had failed to do: they will bear testimony to the glory of God, calling both \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ to faith in Christ.
19. We who are in Christ have also been marked with a seal – the promised \_\_\_\_\_ – who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God’s possession. (Ephesians 1:11-14)
20. Therefore, we work out (not for) our salvation with fear and trembling, that we might be \_\_\_\_\_ of God’s grace, glory, and love, that others may come to seek and to know new life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
