Two Men Walked With Jesus - Palm Sunday - April 10, 2022

1. While the crowds rejoiced, Jesus wept. What caused His sorrow?
2. To be a disciple was to \_\_\_\_\_. A disciple's desire was to become in his own walk with God, as the rabbi was, in his walk with God.

4. What we learn about Judas leaves us feeling unsettled, perhaps in part because we \_\_\_\_\_ there may be more of Judas in us than we care to admit.
5. Judas' \_\_\_\_\_ reveals his heart. His heart isn't set on the things of God, but on the things of \_\_\_\_\_.
6. "For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and \_\_\_\_\_ themselves with many griefs." (1 Timothy 6:6-10, NIV84)
7. \_\_\_\_\_ for the things of this world can make us do things we never would have dreamed we would ever do and take us to places we never wanted to go.
8. We become \_\_\_\_\_ - both to others and to the work of the kingdom - when we have in mind the things of men rather than the things of God.
9. When our expectations of who God is are based on our own desires, rather than the truth of God's word, we can become \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ with God Himself.
