## Sermon Notes

### In Over Your Head - Acts 2:36-41

1. Jesus instructed His disciple to wait in Jerusalem for the gift that His Father had promised. This was the gift of the \_\_\_\_\_ .
2. When this gift was poured out upon them, they were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues (\_\_\_\_\_).
3. Filled with the Holy Spirit, Peter began to preach and proclaimed that everyone who called on the \_\_\_\_\_ would be saved.
4. Peter shared the good news of Jesus with the crowds that day. Jesus was not abandoned to the \_\_\_\_\_ but raised to new \_\_\_\_\_ by the power of God the Father. He is both Lord and Christ.
5. When the people asked what they should do in light of these truths, Peter instructed them to “\_\_\_\_\_ and be \_\_\_\_\_ ... for the forgiveness of your sins.”
6. \_\_\_\_\_ People became new creations in Christ that day – the old was gone and the new had come!
7. Their understanding of the gospel \_\_\_\_\_ how they lived their lives day by day. (See Acts 2:42-47)
8. Why is it that the lives of so many who profess Christ today continue much as they had before they had received salvation?
9. Could it be that many Christians today regard iniquity in their heart? The Scriptures indicate that if we cherish, or give safe harbor to, sin in our life, then God will not hear our \_\_\_\_\_.
10. When Peter called the people to repentance and baptism, he was inviting them to take a step of faith – moving in \_\_\_\_\_ to the word of the Lord.
11. The pattern we find in the Bible is this: (1) The word of God is preached. (2) People hear and are \_\_\_\_\_ of their sin. (3) They repent and are \_\_\_\_\_ baptized.
12. Baptism is \_\_\_\_\_ presented as optional for the child of God.
13. Belief and baptism are tied together. Jesus has \_\_\_\_\_ that we be baptized. How then can we call Jesus, “Lord,” and yet not do what He instructs us to do?
14. Jesus, Himself, was baptized and has set an \_\_\_\_\_ for us to follow.
15. What we see in Scripture, is that an act of \_\_\_\_\_ on God’s part, is followed by a step of faith and obedience by the recipients of His grace.
16. Baptism is a living illustration of the message of the \_\_\_\_\_.
17. Through baptism we \_\_\_\_\_ with the work, and the person, and the people, of Christ.
18. We are saved by \_\_\_\_\_ rather than by \_\_\_\_\_. However, a genuine faith will express itself in works pleasing to God.
19. Baptism serves as a symbol of your death to your old way of life and of \_\_\_\_\_ to your new life in Christ.
20. If you believe, but have never been baptized, you need to wrestle with why you are unwilling to follow Jesus in obedience. Is it pride? Fear? Something else? How long will you allow a selective faith to keep you from vibrant life in Christ?
