## Sermon Notes

Just Like Us - 1 Kings 17:17-24 - Thanksgiving 2023

1. God's will for us in Christ Jesus, is that we be joyful always, pray continually, and give \_\_\_\_\_ in all circumstances. (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
2. In \_\_\_\_\_ things God works for the \_\_\_\_\_ of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purposes. (Romans 8:28)
3. Each new trial or setback that Elijah faced became the fertile soil through which his \_\_\_\_\_ would \_\_\_\_\_.
4. Faced with difficult circumstances, we must learn to " \_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways \_\_\_\_\_ Him, and He will make your paths straight." (Proverbs 3:5-6)
5. Like the widow, we may \_\_\_\_\_ expect that as we seek to live for God that we will be immune from tragedy, heartache, and suffering.
6. Then, when these things come, we may lash out and \_\_\_\_\_ blame God, or others, or even ourselves, for the trials we face.
7. But if the conviction we feel comes from the Holy Spirit, then the guilt we feel is for our own \_\_\_\_\_ to bring us to repentance and to turn us to God.
8. God may bring us to the end of ourselves that we might learn to \_\_\_\_\_ in, and \_\_\_\_\_ upon, Him.
9. There is a \_\_\_\_\_, when things are going well, that we will focus on the blessings of life, rather than on the \_\_\_\_\_ from whom those blessings flow.
10. While the temptation might be to set our hearts against God when faced with great tragedy and suffering, the better way is to allow these things to turn our hearts to \_\_\_\_\_, and to seek His \_\_\_\_\_ amid them.
11. How "big" is the God you worship? Elijah was \_\_\_\_\_ that there was nothing that God could not do.
12. The death of the widow's son was ultimately for God's \_\_\_\_\_, the validation of the prophet, and the \_\_\_\_\_ of the widow.
13. \_\_\_\_\_ too, was raised from the dead for the glory of God, the validation of the prophetic word of the Lord, and for our own salvation.
14. We come to a God who is \_\_\_\_\_ and unshakeable, One whose word is sure and true, and whose \_\_\_\_\_ never fail.
15. Elijah was a person just like us - not \_\_\_\_\_ in his own right - but made useful to God through a deep, abiding, and growing \_\_\_\_\_.
